Background

Glial cell-derived neurotrophic factor (GDNF) is a protein that, in humans, is encoded by the GDNF gene. GDNF is a small protein that potently promotes the survival of many types of neurons. GDNF, that acts via classical neurotrophic mechanism, has been effective in several pre-clinical models of PD and had some efficacy in parkinsonian patients.

Recombinant Human GDNF Protein is produced by Escherichia coli expression system. The target protein is expressed with sequence of Human GDNF fused with polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus

Bio-Activity

Measured by its ability to inhibit proliferation in SH-SY5Y cells. The ED₅₀ for this effect is <10 ng/mL.

Storage


Store at -20°C. Store the lyophilized protein at -20°C to -80 °C up to 1 year from the date of receipt.

 After reconstitution, the protein solution is stable at -20°C for 3 months, at 2-8°C for up to 1 week. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
